

FDA Launches Cosmetics Direct for Cosmetic Facility Registrations and Product Listings

The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has launched the new [Cosmetics Direct](#) platform for submitting cosmetic facility registrations and product listings required by the Modernization of Cosmetics Regulation Act (MoCRA) of 2022. Member companies can now save drafts of facility registrations and product listings in Cosmetics Direct. Related [FDA guidelines](#) are available. The FDA previously announced a [compliance policy](#) that extended the deadline for submissions, moving the compliance date from Dec. 29, 2023, to July 1, 2024.
