OVERVIEW

The **\$535.7** billion global cosmetics and personal care products industry is a staple of the U.S. economy, providing jobs and labor income and contributing to the gross domestic product. It is responsible for more than 4.6 million jobs; \$203.3 billion in labor income; \$308.7 billion in GDP and \$82.3 billion in federal, state and local tax payments.
